Biographical/Historical Sketch

Henry L. Reinhold, Jr. was born in Philadelphia in 1869 and studied at the Drexel Institute, the Spring Garden Institute, and the Pennsylvania Museum and School of Industrial Art. Between 1894 and 1901 he and Clarence E. Schermerhorn (1872-1925) worked in partnership under the name Schermerhorn & Reinhold. After dissolution of the partnership, Reinhold continued in independent practice until at least 1932, primarily in residential design.

The collection comprises four architectural construction drawings dated February 20, 1905 for the William P. Buchanan Residence, Wildwood Beach, New Jersey.
